

## **Tax preparation workshop**

Cope Family Center is hosting a “Super Saturday” Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Clinic at Napa Valley College on Saturday. Working families can get their taxes prepared at no cost at this and all Napa County VITA sites. Super Saturday clinic hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and no appointment is necessary.

To qualify for free tax preparation services, taxpayers’ income must have been less than \$42,000 in 2007. US Citizen is not required for participation in this program.

Free tax clinics will be offered through April at all county Family Resource Centers, including Cope Family Center (252-1123), American Canyon Family Resource Center (363-5086), Calistoga Family Center (942-6206), and St. Helena Family Resource Center (963-1919). Taxpayers should contact their local Family Resource Center directly for clinic hours and appointments.

Necessary documents include: Social Security cards for each family member or ITIN number for each working adult; W2 and other income forms; childcare provider name, address and tax ID number; bank routing and account numbers for checking and savings accounts; and landlord’s name, address and phone number for renter’s credit.
